Ordinance Structure-Requirement Distinctions

The following are the categories of **Project Site** and **Project** that would be used to determine the applicability of specific ordinance requirements. These categories define both classifications of development and sites. At this concept level, a brief description of the applicability is provided. As specific ordinance language is developed, it may be that these distinctions will merge or more pertinent distinctions are drawn.

Project Sites

1. Degree of Development will be defined by % total impervious area (TIA).
Distinctions are envisioned for those sites with less than 15% TIA, greater than 15% TIA but less than 50% TIA, and greater than 50% TIA.
2. May be “-With” or “-Without” Waters of DuPage County
3. May BE “-With” or “-Without” Regulatory Floodplain

Projects

1. Those not meeting the requirements of the categories below will be Classified by one or more of the following
 - a. Change in Impervious area
 - b. Grade changes
 - c. Modification of existing structures
 - d. Construction of new structures
 - e. Modifications of existing buildings
 - f. Construction of new buildings
 - g. Illicit discharge
2. Linear Transportation Project-Vehicle and pedestrian facilities in linear land holdings created for that purpose.
3. Naturalization Project-A project, or a portion of a larger project, whose purpose is
 - a. Streambank Stabilization
 - b. Wetland Bank
 - c. Wetland Mitigation Bank
 - d. Water Quality Improvement
 - e. Stream, stream habitat, and Upland habitat Restoration; and Forestry management activities
